

Questions and Answers

Q. How far will this building project carry us into the future? And, what will the capacity of the Sanctuary be?

A. The plan is this phase will provide for 50% greater capacity which should carry us for several years. The team is making sure the site is properly prepped for future growth. The Sanctuary capacity is still under discussion.

Q. Will the current geo-thermal unit handle the addition?

A. No, other options for HVAC are being discussed.

Q. Will the canopy be part of the final design? (Absolutely needed.)

A. Right now, yes.

Q. How will the current space be used when Phase 2 is complete?

A. We know which spaces will be re-purposed but not specific use of each one. Storage, adult groups studies, and a prayer room are on the list.

Q. How big is the current space, and how big is the new space?

A. 20,000 current; 14.5,000 new

Q. Will this sanctuary continue to be used as a sanctuary when Phase 2 is complete?

A. Yes, until new sanctuary is built.

Q. Where will the walkways be?

A. In from the courtyard, at main entrances as well as current ones.

Q. How conservative is the estimate? Does it take into consideration the economy down periods?

A. If economy impacts giving, construction will have to stop. The economy ups and downs have not been factored into this estimate.

Q. How was the design of Phase 2 determined?

A. Partly from the congregation study done in 2014.

Q. Where is the outside entrance going to be when the sanctuary is built?

A. Phase 2 entrance will be used; secondary doors leading out of the church from the sanctuary; could change with any new designs

Q. Does the \$5M include furnishings?

A. Some, but not all.

Q. What will the surface area of the courtyard be made up of?

A. Mostly hardscape; drainage issues have been factored in.

Q. Was the roof designed for functionality or form?

A. Form to accommodate future phase design

Q. Where is the children's play yard?

A. Not decided yet, but there will be one.

Q. Where is the end of the property?

A. Parallel to the end of the sidewalk along the soccer field to Rt 150 to Tennessee Ave to Ackerman's property fence line. Own 40 acres.

Q. Will financing even be available to us?

A. Two financial institutions have expressed interest.

Q. What is our current attendance?

A. 300 - 350 weekly average

Q. Is there a way to consolidate all of the numbers we saw to make it easier to talk about?

A. We need:

\$1.9M cash in hand

\$350,000 in received pledges

\$2.75M in loans
